- The Buyer Planner leads end-to-end supply chain activities for the Technical Operations Group. This is a new, high-profile, and progressive role will establish the CONTINUUS Pharmaceutical Logistics Supply Chain.
- Responsible for all day-to-day activities focused on the procurement, planning and delivery of assigned material and suppliers.
- As a Materials Buyer/Planner Specialist, you will be responsible for:
- Interfacing with Production, Planning, and suppliers to schedule the receipt of material to meet production demands.
- Scheduling materials, updating delivery dates, procurement follow-up and expediting suppliers.
- Evaluating and driving resolution on all manufacturing material quality and supply issues.
- Working with the operations team to convert the demand plans into physical orders. Understands business trends, opportunities and how they impact the demand forecast.
- Analyzing incoming demand identifies order exceptions, misalignment with product rationalization strategy and opportunities to utilize existing inventory.
